The Esplanade Arts & Heritage Centre is a marvel of contemporary Canadian architecture on traditional Blackfoot territory, just steps from the South Saskatchewan River. From its rooftop terrace, you can see Saamis, the shoreline escarpment which is the setting for the story of how Medicine Hat got its name when it started as a railroad town.

Our Journey starts on October 29 in Auckland where we will spend a couple of days sightseeing.

If you are intrigued by Japanese culture, this 15-day/14-night home-hosted Journey will give you an excellent opportunity to explore the rich heritage of two different regions of the country: Aichi Prefecture (Oct. 27 - Nov. 3) and Oita Prefecture (Nov. 3 - 10).

Ambassadors will meet with their hosts at Chubu Centrair International Airport in Nagoya, in the early afternoon of Oct. 27. The next six days will take us to several museums of this highly industrialized region, (including the Toyota Museum of Industry and Technology, Noritake China/Porcelain Museum, Seki Samurai Sword Museum, and the Tofu Factory); to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Shirakawa-go in the mountains of Gifu Prefecture by charter bus tour; to Japanese Gardens, Shinto Shrines, Buddhist Temples, and to ancient Inuyama Castle.

On Nov. 3, we will fly from Nagoya to Kumamoto, from where a charter bus will transfer us to Taketa, Oita Prefecture. During this second week we will experience a Japanese thermal bath (Onsen); walk around the geothermal areas of Beppu; walk in kimonos on the streets of Kitsuki; enjoy a Japanese tea ceremony; marvel at the colors of autumn while hiking in Kuju Highlands; visit a Sake Brewery; and meet with junior high school students to learn about each other's cultures.

There will be a free day during each week to do optional activities with your host. The host clubs will also have welcome and farewell events for us. Our program will conclude on Nov. 10, when a charter bus will take us from Taketa back to the airport in Kumamoto. From that point ambassadors will have the chance to either continue traveling to other regions of Japan on their own, or they can return to Nagoya and return to the United States.

The dream Journey starts with a seven-night homestay in the colorful, fun city of of Bogotá, Colombia. Some of the sites we will visit are the Ministry of Culture of Colombia, Museum Santa Cara, Monteserrate Hill, Rose Farm in Tocancipa, and The Gold Museum. We will also visit the Basilica Nuestra Senora de Fatima, Universidad de la Sabana, Salt Cathedral, Museo Botera, Boyaca Bridge, and Villa de Leyva, Usaquen are some of the other stops. We will be entertained with lively music and Latin dancing at the welcome and farewell parties.

We will continue our Journey and fly to Quito, Ecuador for three nights where we will stay at Patio Andalusia Hotel which is close to the old town. Two days of tours will take us to Pululahua Volcano and visit the Intinan Museum where we will stand in the northern and southern hemispheres at the same time. Many other famous sites will be visited in Quito. A visit to Otavala will awe us with the views, and we will be able to shop in the famous handicraft Indian market. The day will be filled with scenic beauty of the Andes of Ecuador.

Off we fly to Baltra in the Galápagos Islands where an exciting adventure awaits with viewing incredible, rare animals, birds, sea creatures, and geological formations. The professional tour is six-days/five-nights and visits four to five islands. It will be a Journey of a lifetime that many people have on their bucket list.

We fly back to Quito where ambassadors will fly back home or continue on the optional four-days/three-night HUAORANI Amazonian Encounter. The \$920 extension cost includes a night before and after the Amazon Encounter. We will be visiting the Amazon Basin with a stop along the way to enjoy the Hot Springs in Papallacta. We will travel down the Arahuno River in a motorized canoe before arriving at Itamandi Lodge, our lodging place. You will visit an animal rescue center and a local Kichwa community and their farm. We will spend one full-day encountering the Huaorini tribe that were first contacted by civilization in 1956. We will learn about their culture, including eating a meal, watching a blowpipe competition, and seeing their ceremonial dancing and handicrafts. On our way back to Quito we will visit a parrot licking spot and see hundreds of colorful parrots. Your pre- and post-Amazon accommodation is Posada Mirolinda Hotel located near the airport.
